

Karst Trail in the Südharz A ramble through breathtaking nature

There are caves, sinkholes, dolines, karst springs, rock faces and much more to be discovered on a hike on the Karst Trail. The Trail, which is 233 km long in all, runs through the stunning scenery of the Südharz (South Harz) and offers all kinds of interesting discoveries.

Josephskreuz, Stolberg High aloft ...

You can enjoy a magnificent view of the Harz landscape from the 38-metre double iron cross on Mount Auerberg near Stolberg. In fine weather, you'll be rewarded for climbing the 200 steps with a panoramic view as far as Mount Brocken.

The Bandweg trails around Stolberg Hikes for the heart and soul

These hiking trails running around Stolberg offer spectacular views of the half-timbered town yet lead the hiker into a quaint, natural forest that surrounds them with a wonderful sense of peace and quiet. Only in the distance can the sounds of the nearby town be heard when one looks down into the valley. The Upper Bandweg is about 9 km long and can be walked in 2.5 hours. The shorter route, the Lower Bandweg, is only 3.2 km long and offers equally delightful views.

Heimkehle Gypsum Cave, Uftrungen

Magical cave adventure

The "Heimkehle" near Uftrungen is the largest gypsum show cave in Germany. Experience the fascination of cave chambers up to 22 metres high, crystal-clear cave lakes, bats in winter and a light installation in the "Great Cathedral"!

Bauerngraben near Breitungen Now you see it, now you don't

The "Bauerngraben" is a large brook sink and one of the most striking geological phenomena in the gypsum karst. Depending on whether the swallow holes that drain off the water underground are obstructed or clear, the lake basin fills or empties. You can learn about this phenomenon on a guided walk in the biosphere reserve.

Crane migration A bird of good fortune

One of the most striking natural spectacles in the region is undoubtedly the annual flight of the cranes around the Kelbra Reservoir.

Particularly in the autumn months, you can see thousands of cranes landing in the Helme Lowlands to gather fresh strength for the onward flight.



Karst Landscape Biosphere Reserve, Südharz Nature, culture, history

The extensive cultural and natural landscape of the Biosphere reserve covers an area of approx. 30,000 hectares along the gypsum karst mountain range and in the wide-ranging deciduous forests of the Südharz. Diverse landscapes, geological rarities and a diversity of flora and fauna await the visitor. You can find out about life in and with nature on hikes, cycling tours, exhibitions and different courses and projects organised by the Biosphere Reserve.

The little village of Questenberg, situated in the midst of the Südharz karst landscape, conveys living history and tradition with its "Questenfest". At the highest point of the mountain, on a hump of gypsum, stands the "Queste" – an ancient sun symbol with a rich past.

Potholes and brook sink of the Dinster in the Südharz

Testimonies to Earth's history

On a hike in the Südharz, you can find curious rock formations such as the glacial kettle basins in the Nassetal valley, or discover underground water systems like the Dinster brook sink near Questenberg. Both phenomena are centuries old and came into being due to rocks dissolving in the gypsum karst. The potholes are up to 3 metres deep and the Dinster brook mystically vanishes underground.

Kaiser-Otto-Höhenweg Imperial hiking pleasure

The 14 km hiking trail leads over the mountain ridge between Sangerhausen and Bennungen, along the northern edge of the Goldene Aue valley in the Südharz Karst Landscape Biosphere Reserve. The trail was named to mark the 1100th anniversary of the birth of Otto the Great. It offers magnificent views between the Allstedt Forest and the Thuringian Gate in the Goldene Aue, and of the Kyffhäuser hill range.

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Rock nature trail and circular reservoir trail in the Wippertal valley All the way round on foot

The forest and rock nature trail, called the "Knüppeldamm" by locals, starts at the exit from Wippra and runs in a western direction. It leads directly to the reservoir, which you can admire from every side on the 6 km circular hiking trail.

Stretching to the west of the locality of Neckendorf is the "Eislebener Stiftsholz", a very quaint, natural-looking forest area, which is traversed by many hiking trails. Certainly the most imposing part is the Teufelsgrund ("devil's ground"). Local tradition makes out the devil's pulpit and kitchen in the rocky cliffs and crevices.

This variety-filled circular hike leads through a magnificent mixed forest and beautiful meadows, all the way to the foot of the "Hohe Linde" conical slag heap. From the Moltkewarte lookout point you have a view over the whole landscape around the southern Harz foreland, with a panoramic view of the town of Sangerhausen, the Goldene Aue valley and the Kyffhäuser Natural Park. The 6 km hiking trail can be walked in about 2 hours.

The biggest public festival in Central Germany

The biggest public festival in Central Germany is the highlight of the autumn and the perfect excursion tip not just for adrenalin-junkies and fans of festival tent fun, but also for families, food-lovers, romantics and the tradition-conscious. In short, no matter whether old or young – everyone will find something to their liking in the diverse programme and the spectacular attractions. The Wiesenmarkt always takes place on the third weekend in September and is the event highlight in the region.

A fight breaks out between Spring (colourfully adorned young "Whitsun lads") and Winter (the "mucky pigs", who bathe in mud). The lads' task is to drive out winter by cracking their whips.

Roses meet art

Large outdoor art exhibition in the Europa-Rosarium in Sangerhausen

Every year from 1 July till the first Saturday in August, artists from across Germany showcase their art amidst the largest collection of roses in the world.

As you ambulate through the 13 hectares of park grounds, you will find something new to discover at every detour. Hundreds of works of art are harmoniously embedded into the unique splendour of the roses. Admire sculptures up to three metres tall made from the most varied materials: steel, marble, stone, glass, wood and even waste are the raw materials of artistic inspiration.

And on the first Saturday in August, for the closing event of the open-air exhibition, the artworks are artfully illuminated with sophisticated lighting effects.



Every July on Lake Süsser See, you can see the traditional big "Fire and Water" multimedia show, with a huge synchronised music & firework show. The event offers several fantastic highlights, such as the exciting Dragon Boat Race, several bands and DJs, who create the right party mood and a small promenade.

Novalis at Oberwiederstedt Castle

Philosophy and the fine arts

Oberwiederstedt Castle is the birthplace of the early Romantic poet Friedrich von Hardenberg, who was called "Novalis". It houses a museum, an early Romanticism research centre and, with the MuseumsAkademie Novalis education centre, is a place where knowledge is conveyed to young and old alike.

Mining Adventure Centre

The Mining Adventure Centre is situated in the midst of the historical mining landscape of the south-eastern Harz foreland. A striking landmark is one of the oldest operating steel winding towers in Europe. At a depth of 283 metres, the visitors have a first-hand experience of the history of copper slate mining in the region.

There are special tours for adventurers who want to discover the fascinating underground universe of mining in a different way, for instance by canoe or on foot in knee-deep water.

Railway romance

The nicest way to explore the Wippertal valley is to travel from Klostermansfeld/Benndorf to Wippra on the Wipperliese. On the 20-km route, the traditional train rushes past valleys, meadows and fields. Highlights are the railway viaduct in Mansfeld, the Vatteröder Pond, Rammelburg and the terminal station Wippra with the reservoir.

Alte Hettstedter Druckerei printing press in Heise

Printing technology from the 19th century

In 1831, the Hettstedter Wochenblatt was printed in the Alte Hettstedter Druckerei in Heise. Today technical artefacts from the printing press are displayed there, for instance a rotary printing press from 1899, a cylinder printing press from 1890 or a linotype for typesetting and casting from 1930. The exhibited technology is unique in Germany for its state of conservation.

Trail of Songs Sing along!

The "Straße der Lieder" (Trail of Songs) starts at the Schindelbruch nature resort and leads the musically minded through the idyllic landscapes of the Harz. At 14 song stations, song texts on various subjects associated with the hike are displayed. At the final station for example, in front of the Joseph Cross, one finds the song "Die Gedanken sind frei" (The mind is free), because that is exactly what hikers should be experiencing at the end of the trail, up on the heights of the Auerberg hill.

HISTORY & REFORMATION

Mansfeld-Südharz is the birthplace and site of the works of two important personalities who significantly influenced the Reformation through their ideas and their actions. In the land of Martin Luther and the home of Thomas Müntzer, the traces of a momentous past can still be seen around every corner.



Luther's birth house, Eisleben Where Luther came into the world

Martin Luther was born on 10th November 1483 in Eisleben. Luther's birth house is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and gives a comprehensive insight into the life of the great reformer. In the exhibition "I come from here – Martin Luther and Eisleben", over 250 exhibits are on display, impressively illustrating Luther's life.

The sacrament of baptism

A special point of interest is the baptismal font in which Martin Luther was baptised on 11th November 1483. Since 2012, the late-Gothic hall church has shone in new splendour. The lines of windows and floor run towards a baptismal font, into which water flows ceaselessly.

Luther's childhood home "I'm a child of Mansfeld"

Throughout his life, Martin Luther felt a connection to the town of Mansfeld. A few months after he was born, the family moved from Eisleben to Mansfeld, where Luther's father Hans worked as a master smelter. The exhibition in Luther's childhood home gives an insight into the everyday life of the family. Outstanding archaeological finds show what the Luthers ate at mealtimes, how they dressed and what toys the reformer-to-be played with as a child.



St. Georg's Church, Mansfeld Luther's home church

The single-nave hall church of St. Georg proudly stands right in the heart of the Old Town of Mansfeld. Besides the magnificent tombs of the Mansfeld counts, the church also houses an organ built by Furtwängler, a fulllength portrait of Martin Luther by Lucas Cranach, and three altars dating from the 15th and 16th century.

Mansfeld Castle Live like a count

Mansfeld Castle was the ancestral seat of the Mansfeld counts. Today, a Christian youth education centre and meeting point welcomes visitors on leisure and school trips. The late-Gothic castle church and the fortress ruins are particularly worth seeing, and there's a superb view from the valley bastion of the fortress. The "Wächterstube" ("guardroom") Café not only offers information and souvenirs, but also mouth-watering treats.

The miners' church of St. Annen is one of Germany's most beautiful Renaissance churches. The Augustinian monastery adjoins the church. The monks' cells, with their quaint gables, are preserved in their original state. Martin Luther was a regular guest here.

Luther's last residence, Eisleben Luther's last journey

Martin Luther travelled time and again to the town of his birth, Eisleben. On his last trip, he died there on 18th February 1546. The house where Luther died, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is dedicated to the last days and hours of the reformer.

The exhibition "Luther's Last Journey" describes his stay in Eisleben and looks at the whole topic of dying and death. One of the most important exhibits is the original pall that covered Luther's coffin in 1546.

Helfta Convent The crowning glory of German nunneries

The Helfta Convent is situated at the edge of the Luther town Eisleben. In the 13th century, the three great mystics Gertrud von Helfta, Mechthild von Hakeborn and Mechthild von Magdeburg lived here. For something a little more reflective, you can head for instance to the Gertrudkapelle chapel, designed by the Brazilian artist Claudio Pastro. Guided tours can be booked.

The Luther family also had a close connection to the villages in the Mansfelder Grund collective municipality. Luther himself personally arbitrated in a dispute between the people of Hergisdorf and Eisleben. The result was that the Hergisdorfers were allowed to go on brewing their own beer. Today, a relief of the reformer at St. Ägidius' Church still testifies to his strong connection to the village.

A memorial was erected here to process and remember the brutality of the Nazi regime in Manseld Land. A permanent exhibition draws attention to the history of the subcamp and the misuse of the old salt mines under the Nazi regime.


